## **Compost Bin Sale and Compost Seminar!**

The Metropolitan Environmental Trust (The M.e.t.) is collaborating with Tulsa Master Gardeners and Oklahoma Cooperative Extension Service to offer an informative Seminar on composting on Saturday, October 20<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 A.M. to noon. There will also be a compost bin sale during this event. Both the seminar and sale will be held at the OSU Extension center in Tulsa at 4116 E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street.

"From the dust bowl to Green County, we are making compost important for Oklahoma," Explains The M.e.t's Executive Director, Michael Patton. The four hour program is hosted by the most knowledgeable people on dirt in Tulsa! The course will cover everything from the biology of soil, to the failures of composting with a demonstration on how to build a compost bin at the end. The seminar is \$10 but one will receive a \$10-off coupon to use when purchasing a Garden Gourmet compost bin during the seminar. The bins are sold at a discounted rate of \$45 (\$35 with the coupon). This is thanks to the City of Tulsa for financial assistance.

If one does not want to participate in the seminar they are free to come by from 9:00 A.M. to noon to purchase a compost bin. Space is limited for the seminar but it is not sold out yet. The media is asked to come out at 9:30 A.M. to cover the event.
