Dear Cardinal students, families, and patrons,

This letter is to inform you of the district's decision to close school on **Thursday and Friday (April 5th and 6th)** due to the continued teacher walk-out.

Notes:

- Schools will not be open to the public on **Thursday or Friday**, with the exception of our designated meal sites at the Middle School and Upper Elementary cafeterias from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. for Breakfast and 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for Lunch. These are "grab and go" style meals that are being provided free of charge for the students of our community.
- All extracurricular activities will go as scheduled. No practices, meetings, etc. will be held during the regularly scheduled school day which has been designated from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
NOTE: The Prom will continue as scheduled on April 7th.
- *Tulsa Career Tech classes will continue as scheduled. Normal transportation from Collinsville High School to the various Tech campuses will continue at their normal times.*
- *Tulsa Community College classes will continue for concurrently enrolled students at their normal times.*

At this time, an overwhelming majority of our teachers have signaled their intention to continue the walkout on Thursday. We were already scheduled to be out of school on Friday. Our intention is to be open and resume school on Monday, April 9th. If anything changes between now and then, we will notify you as soon as possible. As it stands after Friday (April 6th), we will need to use the April 13th, April 20th, and April 27th days (all Fridays) that we have on our calendar as "No School" to make up the days we have missed up to this point. Again, this is our plan right now. However, if the situation changes, we will notify you as soon as possible.
