Dear Cardinal students, families, and patrons,

This letter is to inform you of the district's decision to close school on **Tuesday, April 3rd** due to the continued teacher walk-out regarding the restoration of consistent and positive funding from our State legislation after at least 10 years of cutbacks and reductions in State funding.

Notes:

- Schools will not be open to the public on **Tuesday, April 3**, with the exceptions of our designated meal sites at the Middle School and Upper Elementary cafeterias from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. for Breakfast and 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for Lunch. These are "grab and go" style meals that are being provided free of charge for the students of our community.
- All extracurricular activities will go as scheduled. No practices, meetings, etc. will be held during the regularly scheduled school day which has been designated from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
NOTE: The Prom will continue as scheduled on April 7th.
- *Tulsa Career Tech classes will continue as scheduled. Normal transportation from Collinsville High School to the various Tech campuses will continue at their normal times.*
- *Tulsa Community College classes will continue for concurrently enrolled students at their normal times.*
- **On Tuesday, April 3, we are giving the ACT test to all Juniors at the High School from 8:00 a.m. to approximately 1:00 p.m. Students need to bring a pencil for testing and a snack for break time.**
- On Wednesday, April 4, we will give the Junior Science test at the High School from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

At this time, there is still a need for some of the parts of the revenue bills that have passed to be fully funded and fully finalized (Governor's signature) legislatively. Our intention has and will always be to have school; however, we will only do so as long as we have it staffed at a safe and efficient level with our certified staff. With that in mind, we will have to make that determination on a day-to-day basis as the situation is very fluid and dynamic.
