RESOLUTION 2019-13

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF COLLINSVILLE TO EXECUTE THIS RESOLUTION AND HAVE IT PUBLISHED AS REQUIRED BY LAW, CALLING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, OKLAHOMA, ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 11, 2020, AND, IF NECESSARY, ON TUESDAY, APRIL 7, 2020, SAID ELECTION TO BE THE BIENNIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR WHO SHALL BE ELECTED AT LARGE FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS; AND TWO COMMISSIONERS FROM WARDS I AND II TO BE ELECTED BY THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THOSE WARDS TO SERVE FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR YEARS AND UNTIL THEIR SUCCESSORS ARE ELECTED AND QUALIFIED.

WHEREAS, it is required by the Charter of the City of Collinsville that there be a biennial election for the purpose of electing a Mayor who shall be elected at large to serve for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, it is required by the Charter of the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, that there be a biennial election for the purpose of electing two commissioners from Wards I and II to serve a period of four years who shall be elected by the voters of their respective Wards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COLLNSVILLE, OKLAHOMA:

- **Section 1.** The duly elected, qualified and acting Mayor of the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, acting in that capacity is hereby authorized, ordered and directed to publish this resolution calling for a biennial election for the purpose of electing a Mayor, who shall be elected at large for a term of two years, and two Commissioners from Wards I and II to serve for a period of four years each to be elected by the qualified electors of their respective Wards and until their successors are elected and qualified.
- Section 2. Said biennial election shall be held on February 11, 2020, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., and if necessary, to be held on April 7, 2020, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Voting shall take place at all polling places within the City of Collinsville and its fence line.
 - **Section 3.** The election shall be a non-partisan election.
- Section 4. The Mayor and City Commissioners shall have been residents of the City of Collinsville one year prior to their election and shall be qualified voters of good moral character, not in litigation with the City, and not under 25 years of age. City Commissioners shall be residents of the Wards they represent.

The filing period for candidates seeking office shall begin at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, December 2, 2019 and end at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 4, 2019. Contest of candidacy may be filed until 5 p.m. on Friday, December 6, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma hereby certifies to the Tulsa County Election Board that Tulsa County precincts 501, 502, 503 and 504 are to be opened and certifies that Rogers County precincts 31 and 32 are only partially contained within the City of Collinsville and that precincts 31 and 32 will not be opened because no one resides in that portion to the precincts.
